The route is going to be approx 5 miles and will take approx. 4hrs.

Teams are a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 Cubs.

Each team is required to provide a Warranted Leader, or a CRB / DBS cleared helper on the day, who will be required to wear a Hi Vis vest or Jacket to walk with a different pack marking them on the way, according to our criteria which will be provided on the day. We strongly encourage that all Cubs wear a Hi Vis as well.

Please make sure that your adult is confident and competent with their map reading skills.

No dogs will be allowed to walk with any groups.

Every pack will have a dedicated start time and have 30 mins to plot their route (6 Figure Grid Reference) before being sent on their way.

Each competition team will have a leader from a different group to **GUIDE if needed, NOT TRAIN** them on the route and will be marking them on these skills and teamwork.

The route will be provided on arrival, all participating packs will be given a designated start time that will be shared with those packs attending via email on Sunday 25th March.

All Cubs must wear their **Groups Scarf** and be set for different and varying weather conditions on the day.

Individual Packs must complete an **AN form** for their own section for the event

InTouch contact: – Attached to this document you should find A Registration Form, this needs to be completed and returned, **prior** to the event. Please only complete one form per pack - if you are entering several teams please ensure they are all included on your registration form, please add additional rows as required.

A Health Form: for all the Cubs, Leaders & Helpers is attached to this e-mail. These must be completed for all Cubs and Leaders taking part in this event and be available on the day - a copy of these will be kept with the event team during the course of the event.

No Map Required: We will be supplying a photo-copied part of the map for you and the Cubs. While walking the route the Cubs will have a quiz to do, scores for which will go towards the final team scores.

Results: will be announced via e-mail after the 1st, 2nd, 3rd trophy and certificates have been delivered to the packs.

There will also be a certificate for each Cub pack taking part on the day.

Novice teams: If your pack is unable to take part in the main competition, we encourage you to take the chance for you to input a novice team, they will be able to complete the same route and challenges as the competition allowing the Cubs to gain experience for next year.

All novice teams will go round with their own leader or leaders and will not be marked/ be an active part of the competition.
